

SCRUBBER MAINTENANCE TIPS

Important: Before doing any maintenance on the scrubber, be sure the power is turned OFF or the batteries are disconnected. Fill solution tank with water (not to exceed 60°C/140°F. Pour a recommended cleaning detergent into the solution tank according to mixing instructions on the container)


Daily





- 1. Raise the squeegee assembly off the floor and nwipe the blades down with a damp towel. Be sure to store squeegee in the UP position.
- 2. Lift scrub head up, then remove and clean pad driver(s) Brush(es).



3. Drain both recovery and solution tanks completely of water and solution.







7. Recharge the batteries.

Weekly



. Check connection make sure they are tight and clean (Blue connector).

Monthly



- 1. Check the scrubber for leaks and tighten any loose fasteners.
- 2. Lubricate all grease points and pivot points with silicon spray or approved grease.



3. Place machine over a floor drain. Flush the solution system by pouring 3 gallons of hot water and approved alkaline detergent into the solution tank and running the machine (with solution control on) for 45 seconds. Turn machine off and let it sit overnight. The next day, drain the remaining solution and rinse the solution tank out with clean water.



Daily Storage

ALWAYS... DRAIN both tanks, store machine INDOORS, in a DRY area, in the UPRIGHT position, with the SQUEEGEE UP off the floor, and the PAD DRIVER/BRUSH UP off the floor. If storing machine in an area with freezing temperatures, drain ALL of the fluids out of the machine to prevent damage.

Safety Precautions For Lithium-ion Battery Scrubber

All operators should read, understand and exercise the following safety precautions. Any damage caused by misuse or unauthorized persons will void the warranty.

WARNING! Dismantling battery pack may cause short-circuit. Which can result in explosion or fire. Moreover, dismantling battery pack may cause the leaking of electrolyte. If electrolyte gets into your eyes or any part of your body, please wash with a large amount of fresh water and see a doctor immediately.



- 1. Do not dismantle the battery pack.
- 2. Do not leave battery pack discharged, this will damaged the battery pack.
- 3. Do not short-circuit the battery pack.
- 4. Do not punch or press the battery pack. Do not put heavy objects on the battery pack.
- 5. Keep the scrubber away from fire and flammable objects, keep the battery pack dry.
- 6. Do not cover the battery pack with any electroconductive objects.

Special Attention For Lithium-ion Battery Scrubber

- 1. During the charging process, if there is any abnormal smell or sound, please stop charging the scrubber battery pack immediately.
- 2. During the usage process, if there is any abnormal smell or sound, please stop using the scrubber immediately, and contact the distributor.
- 3. Don't dismantle the battery pack if error occurs, contact your distributor as soon as you can.
- 4. Don't get the battery pack wet, use a dry colth to clean top of battery pack.
- 5. After the batteries are discharge, the batteries must to be charged again in time. If you don't use the batteries for a long time, please charge as this will damage the battery pack, please charge once a month to keep batteries operating correctly if scrubber is not in use.
